### From the Pastor

Happy New Year! It's the start of a new decade... the 2020s.

A new year can help us feel like we can make a new beginning. As we look at the past decade of the 2010s there are likely things we accomplished and can have a sense of pride in. There are also likely things that went wrong and may have turned out poorly. As Pastor Matt Norlen of the the Ceresco Covenant Church reminded us of at our community Thanksgiving Eve worship service, we have had blessings and not-so-blessings. Our God has been the one constant through it all.

I love that we're moving into the year 2020. It reminds me of eye vision. When we can see clearly, we have "20-20 vision". So, this year is a time for us to remember who we are as God's people and seek a clearer vision of how we can live our lives with a greater purpose than just our own.

## IMMANUEL'S THREE DAYS OF PRAYER: January 7<sup>th</sup> – 9<sup>th</sup>, 2020

Immanuel is part of an association of Lutheran congregations across the United States and around the world which prays. On January 7<sup>th</sup> through 9<sup>th</sup>, please set aside some time throughout your day to focus on the prayer themes listed below as we seek to glorify God through our lives and the life of our faith family called Immanuel.

### Day One: January 7

This is a day focused on **confession**. We have made our lives, our relationships—and sometimes even the church—in our own image. We confess that the church belongs to Jesus and not to us. We gather to lay down our pride, our sin and our self-serving agenda and ask Jesus for forgiveness, which He gives freely and with mercy.

### Day Two: January 8

This is a day of **petition**. Pray for Immanuel, for Pastor Scott, for our Church Council members – Ken, Lisa, Justin, Janis, Kathi, Jared and Christie, for our church secretary Fran, for Teresa our church custodian, for Suzy and others involved with the Sunday School, and for those who provide the ministry of hospitality in our church kitchen and in other ways. Pray for all of Immanuel's faith family and friends that they might know God's redeeming love for all people through Jesus Christ.

### Day Three: January 9

This is a day for **vision**. Pray that the Holy Spirit will again move through the hearts and minds of leaders and pastors that God's vision for His church might be revealed and fulfilled. This is a time of prayer for renewal, revival and encouragement. Pray for God's vision for you, Immanuel, Christians in the greater Ceresco area and throughout our world.




