As we go through the season of Lent during March, this is a good time for us to remember who we are and what Jesus as the Son of God did for us.

Just stop and think about it for a moment... It's amazing! The God who created our vast universe took on human form and was born as a baby in a crude manger. As Jesus grew into a man, he gathered disciples who followed him and learned about God's ways of love. He knew feelings like you and me – celebrating at a wedding in Cana where he did his first miracle of turning water into wine, crying

at the tomb of his friend Lazarus before he raised him from the dead, and in anger took a whip and drove out the money changers in the temple in Jerusalem.
