

Growing Deeper Spiritually

Thoughts from Pastor Scott

Do everything without complaining or arguing so that you may become blameless and pure, children of God without fault in a crooked and depraved generation in which you shine like stars in the universe as you hold out the word of life."

Philippians 2:14-15

What does it mean to "grow deeper spiritually?" When did you most grow spiritually? When we are faced with life's challenges, I like to think about the "ABCs of Life". "A" stands for the word "Antecedent." These are the things that happen to us; our circumstances or our situation. - "B" stands for our "Beliefs" about what is happening to us. And, C" stands for the word "Consequences." Consequences are how I feel about something. This is the way that I respond.

2,000 years ago the Apostle Paul had some difficult situations in life but he used them to grow spiritually. First Paul's "A" in life... his "antecedent" was that he was sometimes in prison, tortured and mocked, or poor and hungry. But, rather than let that get him down, his "B" in life... his "belief" was in Jesus as His Lord. In those difficult times, his "C" in life... his "consequence" was that he would rejoice – he would use his life as a conduit where God's love, grace and power could be poured into whatever circumstances he found himself in.

When difficult things happen in your life what is your first response? I have to be honest with you, I sometimes catch myself being upset with God and asking Him "why this is happening to me?" But, then I realized that God is teaching me a lesson in life. So, when difficult things happen to you, what's your usual first response?

- A. I must have done something wrong.
- B. We live in a sinful world, 'stuff' just happens.
- C. What is God trying to show me in this?

As God's people, it's "C" that He wants us to think of first. God is showing us lessons in life and we have an opportunity to grow because of them. Not just for us, individually, but also for us as a church called "Immanuel". This month, let's let our church's prayer be, "God, how could I partner together with YOU in these circumstances right now where I am (or we are)? Thank You that You are "Christ in me, the hope of glory!"
