Some thoughts from Pastor Scott

The "COVID 15"? I don't know about you, but this past year and a half have been a challenge for me to keep from gaining too much weight. Most people have struggled to maintain their weight during the pandemic, with 61% of American

adults reporting undesired weight gain or loss in the past 17 months.

According to a recent WebMD poll of more than 1,000 readers more than half of the respondents said that they'd gained weight "due to COVID restrictions" disrupting their health routines. Some 54% reported that they were exercising less and 68% admitted that they were snacking more.

You might be thinking, what does my faith have to do with my health? Plenty. Jesus once said, "I have come that they might have life and have it to the full" (John 10:10). The life Jesus speaks of is more than just our heart beating or our lungs breathing. Health and wellness has to do with all of our being and who we are.
